GILGAMESH BREWING'S TERRY PORTER BEER RAISES \$50,000 FOR OHSU DOERNBECHER CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

PORTLAND, Oregon (May 10, 2016) – Today Gilgamesh Brewing and its distribution partner, Columbia Distributing, announced that the brewery's limited-edition Terry Porter lived up to its namesake, becoming an instant Oregon favorite. Sales from the porter-style brew raised \$50,000 for OHSU Doernbecher Children's Hospital. The donation was recently presented to the Doernbecher Children's Hospital Foundation at its annual "Heart of Doernbecher" dinner and auction.

"This entire experience has been a dream come true," said Gilgamesh's Matt Radtke. "We are so fortunate to be able to work with an Oregon legend, and utilize our growing business to generate a substantial donation to OHSU Doernbecher. The donation will assist the missions of the OHSU and Doernbecher Children's Hospital to fund a five-story guest house facility at Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU) South Waterfront campus. The project will provide housing for patients and families receiving care at OHSU and OHSU Doernbecher.

Retired NBA player and new University of Portland coach Terry Porter is also a Doernbecher Children's Hospital Foundation board member. He was quick to embrace the concept of the Terry Porter brew and dedicated himself to the entire project, from brewing the first batch to attending many release parties around the state. "I couldn't be happier with the outcome," said Porter. "I'm sincerely grateful for everyone getting behind this in such a huge way. Beer fans, Gilgamesh fans, my fans...they all stepped up."

Columbia Distributing's Oregon President Mark Walen saw the beer's potential and was still amazed by the result. "This was truly a community movement. A sports legend, a craft beer and a good cause was the perfect intersection for an incredible opportunity and Gilgamesh nailed it. We couldn't be happier to have a small hand in the Terry Porter's success."
